The JCC of Greater Columbus Jewish Sports Hall of Fame program was established in 1979 to recognize Jewish individuals who have excelled in the world of athletics. In accordance with the credo of the Hall of Fame, "May their achievements and example light the way for generations to come", many Jewish sports-persons have been inducted into the Hall of Fame since its inaugural event on October 21, 1979.

The following criteria for induction have been established by The Jewish Community Center of Greater Columbus' JCC Sports Hall of Fame Committee:

- Candidate must be Jewish
- Candidate must be 35 years of age or older
- Candidate must have been an outstanding athlete or coach in amateur or professional athletics
- Candidate must be a native of Columbus, or a resident of the Columbus area for a significant portion of his or her life
