WE ROLL ALONG DECEMBER 6 - 21, 2025

Fresh off its 2024 Tony Award win for Best Revival, *Merrily We Roll Along* is Stephen Sondheim's poignant and daringly personal masterpiece. Told in reverse, this semi-autobiographical musical rewinds through the lives of three inseparable friends—composer Franklin Shepard, lyricist/playwright Charley Kringas, and theatre critic Mary Flynn—tracing their journey from youthful ambition to the fractured realities of adulthood. Spanning the glitz and grit of the 1950s to 1970s showbiz world, *Merrily* explores the high cost of success and the fragility of friendship with wit, heart, and Sondheim's signature brilliance.

From legendary Jewish playwright Neil Simon, creator of *The Odd Couple* and *Lost in Yonkers*, comes the touching and laugh-out-loud conclusion to his beloved "Eugene Trilogy." In *Broadway Bound*, Eugene and his older brother Stanley are chasing their dreams of becoming comedy writers in 1940s Brooklyn, while their family is on the verge of falling apart. GALLERY PLAYERS HISTORY

In the late 1940's, the foremost community theater in Columbus was the Players Club Theater. As a club, this group did not permit the participation of African Americans or Jews. Finally, a group of Hadassah women





who were interested in theater met at the home of Florence Zacks (Melton) to organize a theater activity in which members of the Jewish community could comfortably take part.


